



TRAINEESHIP NOTICE

The European Network and Information Security Agency offers **traineeships** for periods of **five months**. The traineeship program aims to provide trainees with work experience in the field of network and information security.

Specifically ENISA requires **trainees** for its operational departments.

Requirements:

- First cycle of university achieved (preferably computer science, mathematics and physics).
- Knowledge and/or expertise in one of the following domains:
 - Emerging Network and Information security technologies
 - Requirements and technologies for monitoring and improving the end-to-end security and resilience of communications networks
 - European standardisation activities on Network and Information security
 - Electronic identity and authentication technologies.
 - Information security statistics
 - Business continuity planning
 - Network and Information security Policies
 - Media or Communication activities (e.g. media, web, audiovisual, event, Intranet, publications)
 - Risks assessment and risk management
 - Security requirements and measures for eCommunication systems resilience

Starting date and duration: The starting date of the traineeship will be determined by the Agency according to its needs.

Applications that do not meet the eligibility criteria or are incorrectly submitted will be rejected.

This call for trainees will remain open throughout 2009 and will be effectively closed on 31st December 2009 13:00 (GMT+2). The first evaluation for traineeships will take place, not before one calendar month lapses, after the publication date of this vacancy notice.

Additional evaluation and selection will take place in line with the needs of the Agency later in 2009 and beginning of 2010.
