Name and contact details of processor	1) Further inductors/contractors/education centers within EU that ENISA (or EU-Learn) employs for the provision of trainings, such as Deloitte, EIPA, Accenture, Abilways etc. 2) Knowbe4 Inc., based in US, only for the provision of an online service for security awareness training for registered ENISA staff (under the supervision of ENISA's ISO). The service has been purchased under the European Commission DG DIGIT FWC SIDE II. ENISA has signed the EC SCCs with the processor for the transfer of personal data to US. 3) LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited, based in Ireland, only for the provision of an (optional) online service for professional learning (LinkedIn Learning) to registered ENISA staff. A specific service contract between ENISA and the processor is in place.
Purpose of the processing	To plan and organise training activities for ENISA staff; to manage the training budget; to keep record of training received by ENISA staff.
Description of data subjects	Staff members that request an external training within the ENISA policy framework for training on individual initiative in the interest of the service, e.g. Temporary agents and Contract agents, as per ENISA's Decision MB/2018/9 on learning and development.
Description of data categories	1) General (ENISA HR): Name; date of entry into service; probationary period end date; unit; grade; work phone number; course foreseen in appraisal report, course details (title, location, duration, fees, etc). 2) Specific for the security awareness training platform (processor KnowBe4): name, email address, telephone number, security awareness training and simulated phishing campaigns results and metrics, IP address, web browser information. 3) Specific for the LinkedIn Learning service (processor LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited): name, email address, LinkedIn Learning user profile and preferences, training courses and results, device and location data, usage logs. Public LinkedIn profile (if user already has an account) can be linked (optional).

<p>Time limits (for the erasure of data)</p>	<p>Personal data are processed by ENISA's HR for up to 5 years after the end of a service or contract with service providers.</p> <p>For the security awareness training platform (processor KnowBe4): the processor will delete all data at any time upon request of ENISA or at the end of the contract (apart from data included in audit trails and back-up systems which will be maintained under the terms and conditions of the EC SCCs signed between ENISA and the processor).</p> <p>For the LinkedIn Learning service (processor LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited): the processor will delete all data at any time upon request of ENISA or at the end of the contract, unless it is required to keep the data in order to comply with applicable laws.</p>
<p>Data recipients</p>	<p>Designated ENISA staff in Human resources (Learning and Development Coordinator and HoHR), Management (line manager of staff member and Head of RD). Designated staff of joint controller. Trainers (processors) providing the training course, for example trainers of the EU Learn tool may also have access to the name of the staff member participating in the course.</p> <p>For the security awareness training platform (processor KnowBe4), recipients include: designated ENISA staff organising the trainings; staff of the processor and its subprocessors, in US.</p> <p>For the LinkedIn Learning service (processor LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited), recipients include: designated ENISA staff administering the trainings; staff of the processor (Ireland), as well as its group company LinkedIn and subprocessors in US.</p>
<p>Transfers to third countries</p>	<p>Regarding the security awareness training platform (processor KnowBe4): The processor is based in US. Transfers of personal data by ENISA to the processor are based on EC SCCs signed between ENISA and KnowBe4. The processor has executed EC SCCs with all its subprocessors involved in the processing (subprocessors are explicitly listed as an Annex to the EC SCCs between ENISA and the processor).</p> <p>Regarding the LinkedIn Learning service (processor LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited): The processor is based in Ireland but the processing entails transfers of personal data to LinkedIn US, as well as to LinkedIn subprocessors in US. Transfers are based on EC SCCs, as incorporated in LinkedIn's data processing agreement.</p>
<p>Security measures - General description</p>	<p>General security policy and technical/organisational measures for ENISA's internal IT systems. Access to data is granted to designated ENISA staff members in line with their job profile and only to data relevant to carry out their tasks. Security measures of EU-Learn platform.</p> <p>Regarding security awareness training (processor KnowBe4): security measures as set out in Annex to the SCCs signed between ENISA and processor.</p> <p>Regarding LinkedIn Learning platform: security measures as set out in LinkedIn privacy policy (<a href="https://www.linkedin.com/legal/dpa">https://www.linkedin.com/legal/dpa</a>).</p>
