In 2002, Horst Samsel became Head of the Administrative Division of the BSI and, as such, was responsible for all central issues of information security within the BSI. Since 2013, he is heading a specialist division of the BSI. Currently, he is serving as Head of Division BL “Consulting for Federal, State and Local Governments”.
