He has worked as a technical engineer in the fields of mobile communications/networks/systems in England (Chelmsford - Cambridge, 1995) and mobile terminal equipment in Cyprus (Nicosia, 1996-1998), as well as Electronic Communications Officer in the Directorate for Electronic Communications of the Ministry of Communications and Works MCW (Nicosia, 1998-2002). During his work at MCW, he had also worked as a National Expert at the European Commission (DG Infso, Unit Satellite and Mobile Communications, Brussels, 2000). As a Senior Officer of Electronic Communications in the Office of the Commissioner of Electronic Communications and Postal Regulation (OCECPR) (Nicosia, 2002 -2017), he was the head of the Technical sector. He coordinated projects and working groups and he was actively engaged in Electronic Communications Regulation (Licensing, Numbering, Naming and Addressing, Access, Collocation, Rights of Way), as well as market surveillance for Telecommunications Terminal Equipment, and ICT.
