

## Grzegorz Minczakiewicz



Grzegorz Minczakiewicz is the Director in charge of 'IT Security' at the Directorate-General for Informatics (DG DIGIT). DG DIGIT is the Commission department responsible for providing digital services that support other Commission services and EU institutions in their daily work and that help public administrations across the EU harmonise their work.

Grzegorz, a Polish national, born in 1972, has served in different roles in the area of IT security in DG DIGIT since 2014 and coordinated the work on securing corporate information systems and networks against cyber-attacks. In this capacity, he has been in charge of corporate cybersecurity policy, strategy, governance and IT security operations in the European Commission. Prior to that, he headed the 'Information and Training Services' unit in the same Directorate-General.

Before joining the Commission in 2010, he worked as a Technology Manager for the European Defence Agency for five years and as Product or Sales Manager in different companies in the telecommunication sector in France and Poland for almost a decade.

He holds a Master of Science and Engineering degree in Electronics and a Specialised Master degree in Mobile Radio-communication.
