

## DECISION No MB/2016/1

### OF THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR NETWORK AND INFORMATION SECURITY (ENISA) ON HANDLING EU CLASSIFIED INFORMATION.

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF ENISA,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 526/2013 of the European parliament and of the Council of 21 May 2013 concerning the European Union Agency for Network and Information Security (ENISA) and repealing Regulation (EC) No 460/2004 and in particular Articles 17(4) and 31 thereof,

Having regard to Commission Decision 2001/844/EC of 29 November 2001 amending its internal Rules of Procedure, repealed and replaced by Commission Decision 2015/444/EC,

Having regard to Council Decision 2013/488/EU of 23 September 2013 on the security rules for protecting EU classified information,

Whereas

- (1) There is a need for the Agency ENISA to handle EU classified information up to the level RESTRAINT UE/EU RESTRICTED.
- (2) The above mentioned Commission and Council decisions provide for an equivalent level of protection of EU classified information and reflect the commitment of the Council and the Commission to ensure a coherent system for the protection of EU classified information throughout the EU system.
- (3) An administrative arrangement on sharing classified information with ENISA, up to the level RESTREINT UE/EU RESTRICTED, has been authorised by the Council of the European Union as of 31 October 2013.
- (4) An administrative arrangement between the European Commission and ENISA on the exchange of EU classified information, up to the level RESTREINT UE/EU RESTRICTED, has been concluded on 8 June 2011.
- (5) In implementing its security rules, ENISA should adopt the best available EU policies and practices regarding the protection of EU classified information, in particular those adopted pursuant to Council Decision 2013/488/EU as well as those to be adopted pursuant to Commission Decision 2015/444/EC.
- (6) These provisions are taken without prejudice to Article 15 of the Treaty of the Functioning of the European Union, to Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2001 regarding public access to agencies' documents and to Decision No MB 2013/14 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Network and Information Security regarding public access to documents.



# HAS DECIDED TO ADOPT THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

#### Article 1

The Management Board of ENISA hereby decides to allow the Agency to handle classified information up to the level RESTREINT UE/EU RESTRICTED.

#### Article 2

In implementing its security rules, ENISA shall adopt the best available EU policies and practices regarding the protection of EU classified information, in particular those adopted pursuant to Council Decision 2013/488/EU as well as those to be adopted pursuant to Commission Decision 2015/444/EC.

### Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its signature.
