In the beginning..



The network was born in a MB meeting discussion in 2004:

‘Board Members, or their alternates, or other officials appointed by the Board Member, could act as a liaison officer for ENISA within his/her own country. The Liaison Officer would be a “facilitator” for ENISA activities within his/her Country’

‘Non structural body BUT of great value’: ENISA’s important point of reference into the Member States

Composition of NLO network



The NLO network consists of (at least) one NLO per member state: 34 members

30 from EU MS, (ES, CY → nominated two NLOs)

3 from each EEA,

1 from European Council and

1 from EC

We have 1/3 of the members who are both NLO and MB members, or alternates *
