








CYBERSECURITY HIGHER EDUCATION DATABASE (CYBERHEAD)

- 40%+ of the master's and postgraduate programmes are mapped to ECSF roles

Framework is the EU reference point for professional skills and competences.


The ECSF is the basis for the Academy to
