Swedish ECCG Operation

- ▶ The CSA certification framework is managed by the Ministry of Defence
- ▶ ECCG matters are approved by all relevant ministries in the Government Offices.
- ▶ Minister of Defence assigned the SE delegate of the ECCG in summer 2019.
- ▶ Since start, Sweden participate in ECCG and associated sub workgroup meetings.
- ▶ Monitor and comment on topics as:
 - ▶ Union rolling work program
 - ▶ EU CC scheme
 - ▶ Cloud scheme
 - ▶ Other schemes considered

Implementation of CSA in Sweden

- ▶ The government established early 2020 an inquiry with the task to propose how to implement CSA certification framework in Sweden.
- ▶ Part 1: How SE is to meet the requirements on the member states as stated in CSA.
- ▶ Part 2: If and how EU certificates can be used to improve cyber security of critical ICT in Sweden.
- ▶ The inquiry made a broad consultation with agencies and stakeholders.
- ▶ Part 1 was presented September 2020 and was sent on referral to relevant stakeholders until end of January.
- ▶ Part 2 is currently in progress.

Swedish CSA inquiry part 1 – summary of proposals

- ▶ A new national legislation that supplements the EU Cybersecurity Act is to be established.
- ▶ Swedish Defence Administration (FMV) assigned role as NCCA.
 - ▶ Powers for supervision, issue penalties, collaboration etc
 - ▶ Penalties proposed to be no less than 1000 € and no more than € 1 500 000.
- ▶ FMV continues to host CSEC, with the latter operating at CSA level high.
 - ▶ Relation with CCRA to be further explored.
- ▶ National cyber strategy should accommodate for certification.
 - ▶ How depends on outcome of part 2 of the inquiry.
- ▶ Cooperation among Swedish agencies regarding cyber certification should be strengthened.

Way forward

- ▶ Receive comments on part 1, and then wait for final proposal and necessary decisions on national legislation by the Government and the Parliament during spring.
- ▶ Continue work on part 2
 - ▶ How to take advantage of EUCC in Sweden.
- ▶ Continue to monitor and contribute to the ongoing work in ECCG, ENISA etc.
