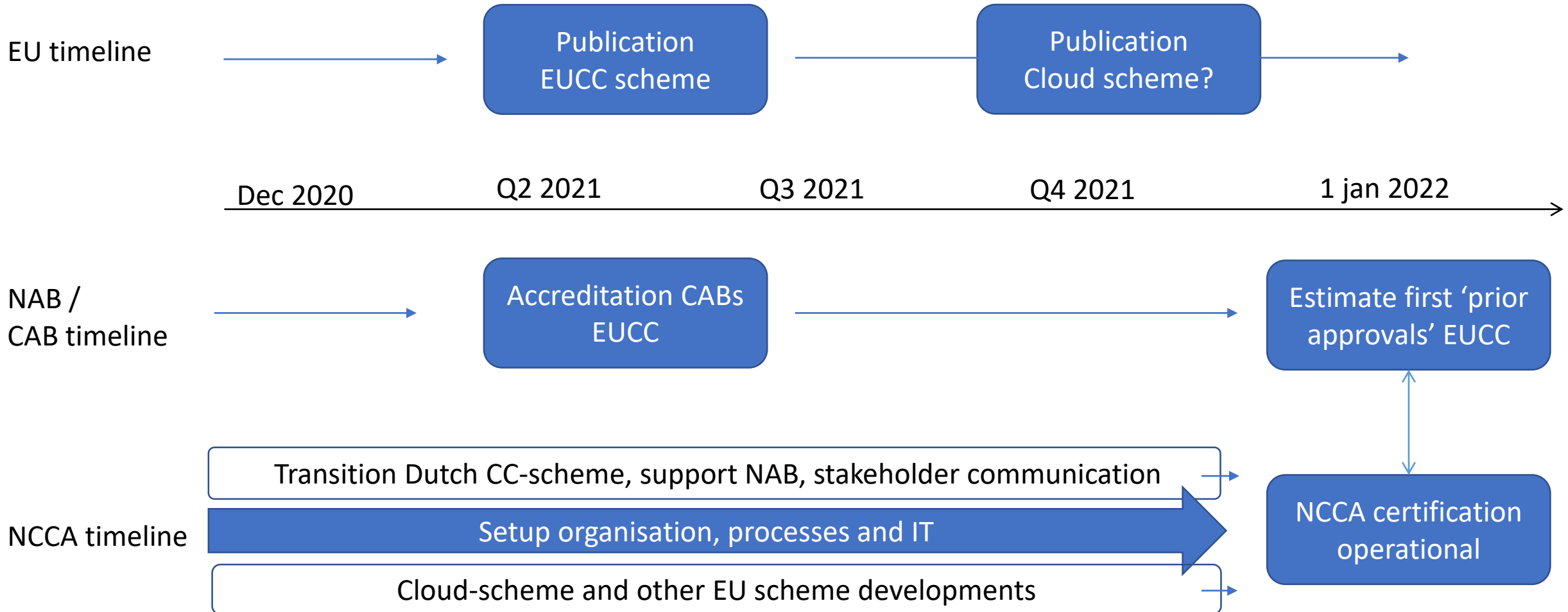

# Overview NL NCCA preparations 2019-2021

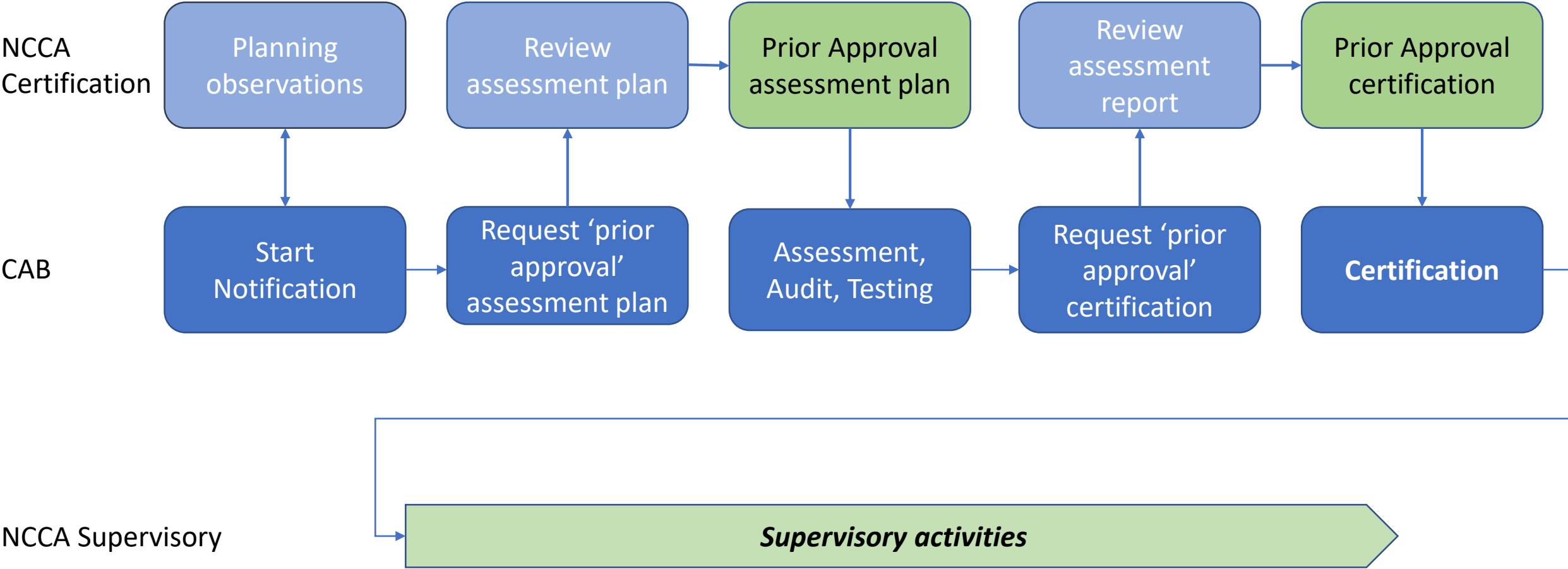
1. Inventory phase early 2019 start CSA project
  - Dutch Telecommunications Agency – NCCA certification and supervisory
  - **CSA Prior Approval option**
  - National CSA implementing law (estimate July 2021 adoption/operational )
  - Planning NCCA
2. NCCA Preparations phase 2020
  - Inform and consultation of (CC) markets of CABs, ITSEFs, manufacturers
  - Consultation/exploration with RvA (NAB) accreditation and NCCA support
  - Organisational view on separation of NCCA tasks of supervision and certification
  - Attraction certification personnel
  - Estimate NCCA budgets 2021 and further
3. Start NCCA team certification January 2021
  - Design and implementation process & procedures
  - Design and implementation IT, dossiers and archive
  - Communication to markets of CABs, LAB's, manufacturers
  - Transition national CC scheme (NSCIB)

# Challenges

1. Transition to EUCC without markets disruption
  - Transferral knowledge/responsibilities from one government agency to another
  - Alignment of certification processes NSCIB national scheme - EUCC
  - Alignment of market demands
2. Managing interdependency and unpredictability
  - Voluntary: workload relates tot markets response.
  - Expected: limited unpredictability for EUCC (existing practice)
  - Expected: great for all other schemes
3. Continuing international recognition Dutch certificates (CCRA)
4. Alignment prior approval dossier – ENISA certification website
