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DATA PROTECTION NOTICE: ENISA ERA CONFERENCE ON RAIL CYBERSECURITY

The "**ENISA ERA Conference on Rail Cybersecurity**" will take place virtually. The conference will officially open on 16th of March 2021 at 10.00 CET and end on 17th of March 2021 at 13.00h, CET. It is co-organised by the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity (ENISA) and the European Union Agency for Railways (ERA).

Your personal data are processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data¹.

The joint data controllers of the processing operation are **ENISA** (Policy Development and Implementation Unit) and **ERA** (Executive Office and Communication Unit), who are responsible for the overall organisation of the conference, the communication with the participants before and after the end of the event. ENISA is also responsible for the collection of data of participants from the online registration of the event's participants. ENISA is responsible for the virtual organisation of the event via an online teleconference platform (Webex).

The data processor of the processing operation are EaudeWeb SRL, which provides the hosting of ENISA web site and other relevant services, and BT Limited Belgian Branch that provides the teleconferencing platform under specific service contract with ENISA². The sub-processor (web conferencing platform) used is Cisco Webex³.

The legal basis for the processing operations by ENISA is article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, on the basis of Regulation (EU) 2019/881 (Cybersecurity Act), especially the provisions establishing the tasks of ENISA. The legal basis for the processing operations by ERA are Articles 5 and 39 of Regulation (EU) 2016/796⁴ of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 May 2016 on the European Union Agency for Railways.

The purpose of this processing operation is to 1) register the participants to the conference, 2) provide access to the virtual sessions, 3) maintain the participants' list, as well as the follow up of the event, including feedback collection and specific communication activities

The following personal data are collected:

- Contact data: first name, last name, function (optional), organisation, country, e-mail address (collected by ENISA upon registration to the event).
- Connection details for virtual session: participants' username, email (optional), device identifiers, IP address, hardware type, operation system type and version, and further technical

connection data. These data are processed by CISCO Webex in order to provide the connection of the event participants to the teleconference platform.

• User generated information: Discussion chat logs, meeting recordings, uploaded files. These data are produced through the CISCO Webex platform during the event. They will be processed by ENISA and deleted from the CISCO Webex platform after the end of the event. Meeting recordings only take place locally at ENISA servers.

Web streaming, filming and recording

Please note that the keynote presentations and panel discussions of ENISA ERA conference on Rail Cybersecurity will be web streamed based on the prior consent of the speakers (presenters/panel participants).

Keynotes and panel discussions will also be filmed, recorded and further uploaded on YouTube, based on the consent of the speakers, after the completion of the ENISA ERA conference on Rail Cybersecurity.

Web streaming and filming will be focused on the speakers only and views of the audience or specific views/pictures of event's participants (other than speakers) will be not be captured.

Still, should you be recorded in the context of keynotes/panels (e.g. while asking a question during a panel discussion), and would like to have certain parts of the videos relating to you removed, please contact us at ENISA-ERA-Conference@enisa.europa.eu and we will do so as soon as possible.

Access to your data is granted only to ENISA and ERA staff involved in the organisation of the ENISA ERA conference on Rail Cybersecurity, designated staff of data processors to the extent that this is needed for the provision of the virtual session, and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF).

The retention periods for the personal data are as follows: the participants' contact data will be kept by the joint controllers for a maximum period of 6 months after the end of the event. The personal data related to the connection to the teleconference platform, will be retained by the relevant processor (BT/Cisco Webex) for the period necessary for the provision of the teleconferencing service. Personal data will be deleted after the end of the retention periods.

Storage of personal data: the contact data collected upon registration at the ENISA website are stored on the ENISA's (and contractor's EaudeWeb) servers and are only processed within EU/EEA. Personal data related to the connection/use of the teleconference platform are stored in BT/Cisco Webex servers within EU/EEA and may include transfers of personal data outside EU/EEA, subject to the provisions of Chapter V Regulation (EU) 1725/2018.

You have the right of access to your personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it. You have the right to rectify your personal data. Under certain conditions, you have the right to ask that we delete your personal data or restrict its use. You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time. We will consider your request, take a decision and communicate it to you. If you have any queries concerning the processing of your personal data, you may address them to ENISA or ERA.
