

Privacy Statement for ENISA's 15 Years Anniversary Event

Your personal data are processed in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data¹.

The data controller of the processing operation is ENISA (Public Affairs Team).

The data processor of the processing operation is ENISA's contractor T&T Executive, which is involved in the event's organisation.

The legal basis for the processing operations is 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 based on the consent of the data subject.

The purpose of this processing operation is to register interested persons to ENISA's 15 Years Anniversary Event, provide access to the conference venue, as well as allow the follow up of the event, including feedback collection and specific communication activities.

The following personal data are collected:

- Contact data: first name, last name, title, function (optional), organisation, e-mail address, phone number.
- Nationality, date of birth and ID/passport information only for the participants that do not have already authorisation to access the event's venue. These data will be used exclusively for security purposes by the venue's provider (European Commission - OIB proximity team Berlaymont) to enable access to the venue.
- Financial data for payment for claims of reimbursement of costs associated with travel (for invited speakers only when applicable).

The recipients of your data will be designated ENISA staff involved in the organisation of the event, designated staff of ENISA's contractor T&T Executive SA, as well as the European Commission (OIB proximity team Berlaymont), which provides the event's venue, for security purposes.

The final participants list (name, surname, organisation, country) will be kept for a maximum period of 5 years after the end of the event for auditing purposes. Your contact data will be kept for a maximum period of six months after the end of the event for communication/follow-up of the event. Financial data (when applicable for invited speakers) will be kept for a period of 7 years after the event for auditing purposes. Date of birth and ID/passport information will be kept only until the completion of the event. Data will be deleted at the end of the aforementioned periods.
