



Privacy policy – Conference: Cybersecurity standardisation

Your personal data are processed in accordance with Regulation 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

The data controller of the processing operation is ENISA - Core Operations Department.

The legal basis for the processing operation is Article 5(d) of Regulation EC 45/2001 and 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 based on the consent of the data subject.

The purpose of this processing operation is to register interested persons to ENISA's conference on Cybersecurity standardisation, provide access to the conference venue, as well as allow the follow up of the conference, including feedback collection and specific communication activities.

The following personal data are collected:

- Contact data: first name, last name, organisation, e-mail address.
- Financial data for claims of reimbursement of costs associated with travel (only for invited speakers).

The recipients of your data will be designated ENISA, CEN, CENELEC and ETSI staff involved in the organisation of the conference, designated staff of ENISA's contractors involved in the event, and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF).

The personal data will be kept for a maximum period of five (5) years after the end of the event for auditing purposes. Data will be deleted at the end of the aforementioned periods.

You have the right to access your personal data and the right to correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal data. If you have any queries concerning the processing of your personal data, you may address them to isdp@enisa.europa.eu.
