



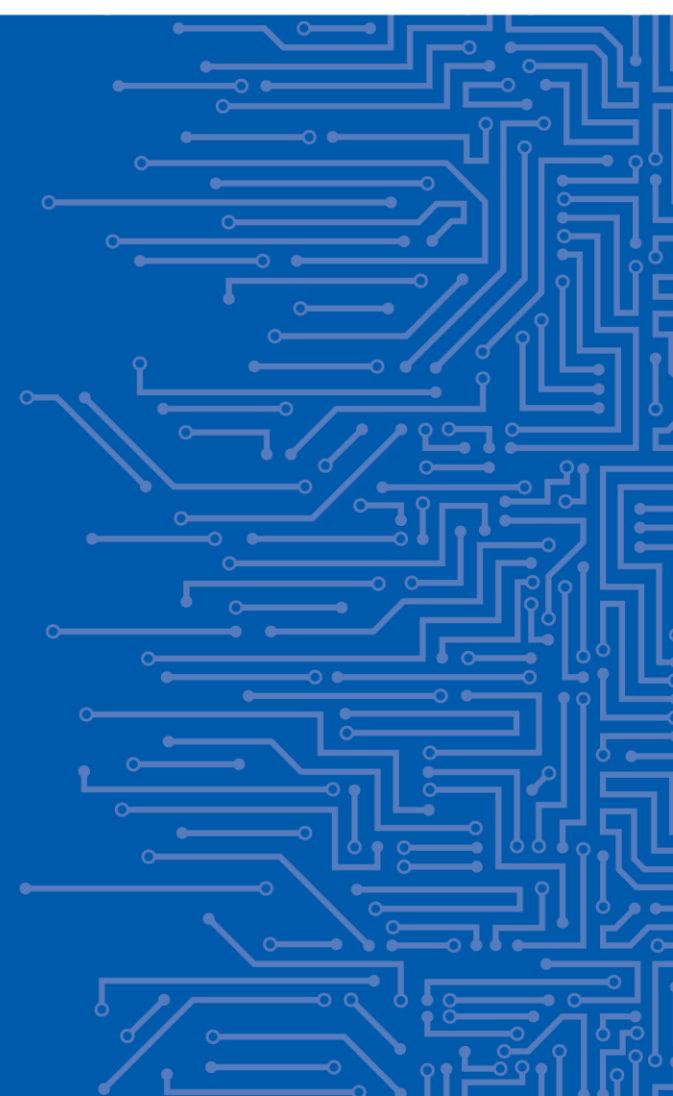

## Influence stakeholders

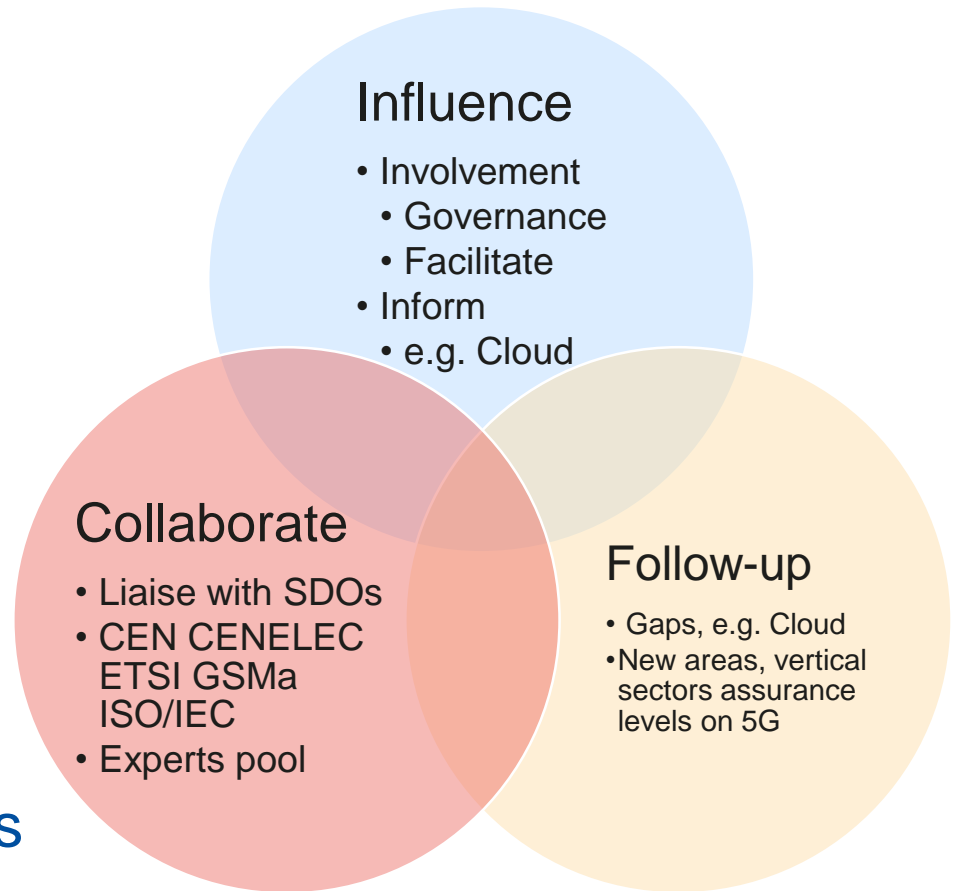

## Collaborate with public interest and private stakeholders

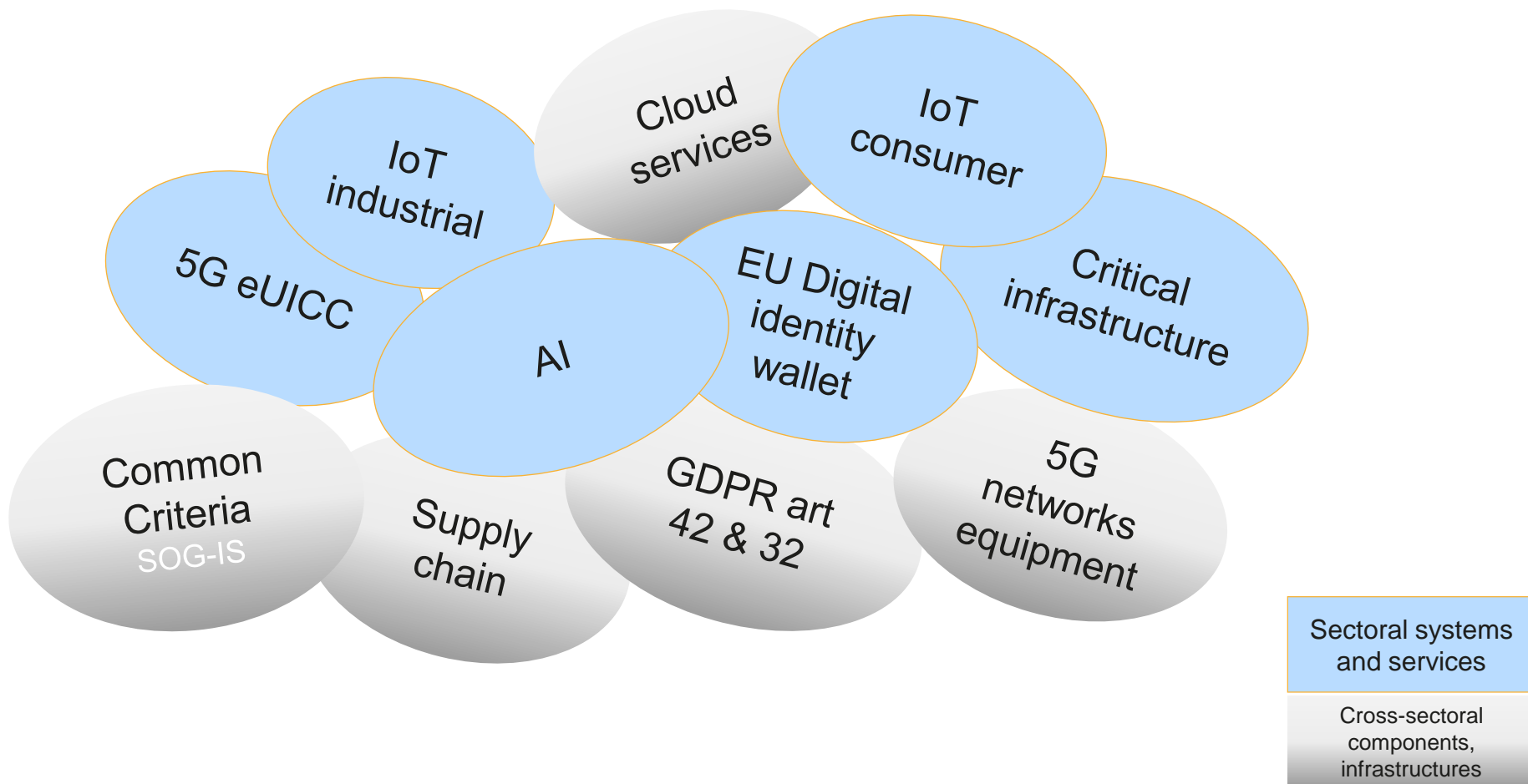
on the use and development of standards

**Assist in translating legal requirements e.g. Rule of Law, to technical and organisational ones**
