

Through the Vienna Agreement and the Frankfurt Agreement, CEN and CENELEC collaborate closely with ISO and IEC

 $\rightarrow$  To align standards to ensure interoperability and removes barriers to trade

**CEN & CENELEC Joint Technical Committee 21 "Artificial Intelligence"** is currently working on standards to support the soon-to-be-published AI Act

CEN and CENELEC are soon expecting a Request from the European Commission to develop standards in support of the upcoming **Cyber Resilience Act** 

CEN & CENELEC feedback on the draft Standardization Request was provided in November 2023 and CEN-CLC/JTC 13 has already started making preparations in anticipation
