

## Industry Event 2018 – Privacy Statement

---

**Your personal data** are processed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 45/2001<sup>1</sup> on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data.

**The data controller** is ENISA (Policy Office).

**The legal basis** for the processing of data is Article 5(d) of Regulation EC 45/2001 based on the consent of the data subject.

**The data processor for the registration service of Industry Event 2018** is T&T Executive SA (through specific contractual agreement with ENISA).

**The purpose** of the processing of personal data is to register interested persons to Industry Event 2018, provide access to the conference venue, maintain the participants' list, as well as allow the follow up of the event, including feedback collection and specific communication activities.

**The following personal data are collected** (upon registration to the event): title, full name, country, organisation, position held, e-mail address and phone number.

**The recipients** of your data will be designated ENISA and T&T staff involved in the event's organisation.

**The final participants' list (first name, last name, and organisation)** will be kept for a maximum period of five years after the end of the event for auditing purposes. All other data will be kept for 6 months after completion of the event.

**You have the right** to access your personal data and the right to correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal data.
