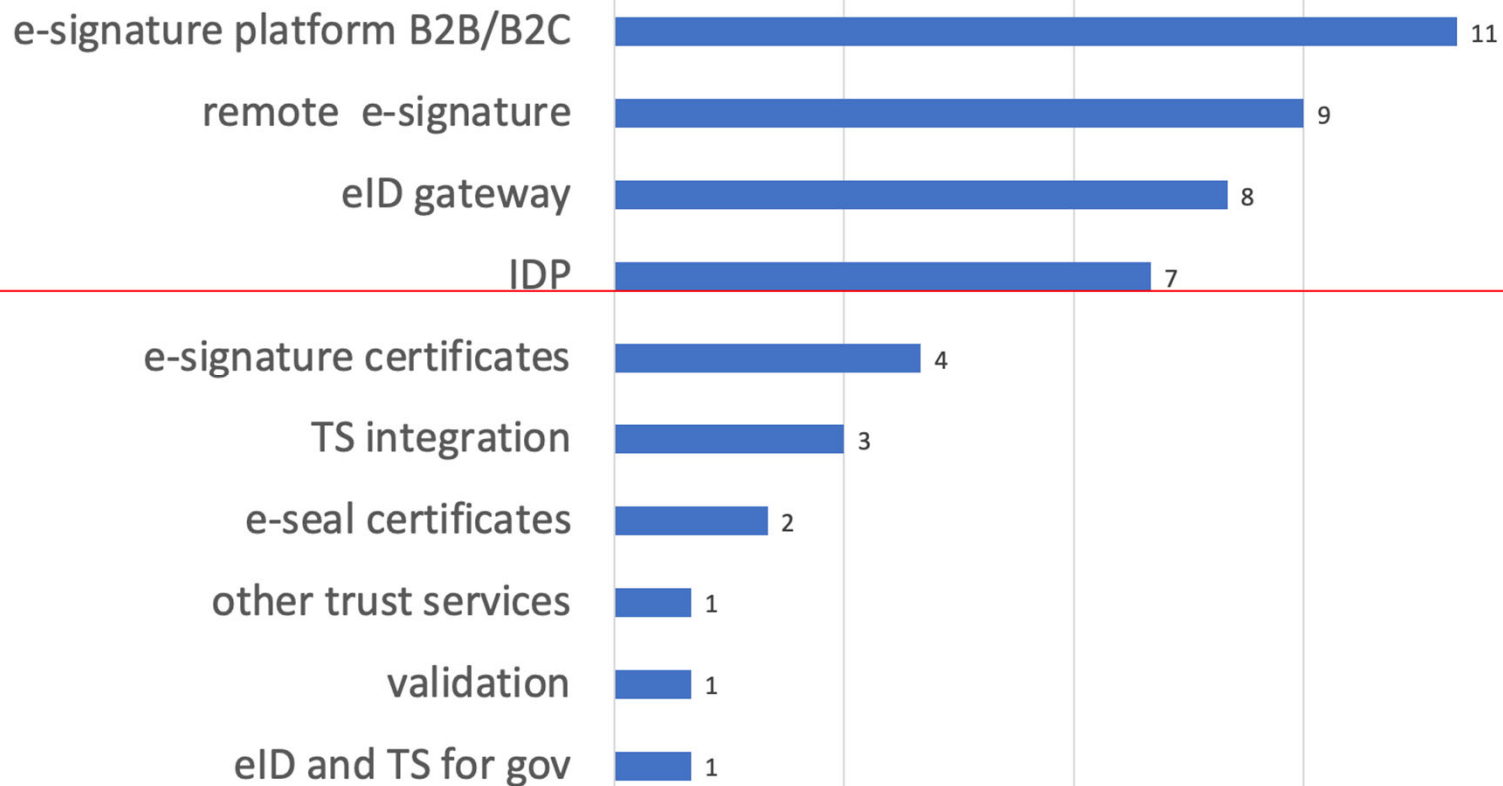


Market 2023 trends forecast

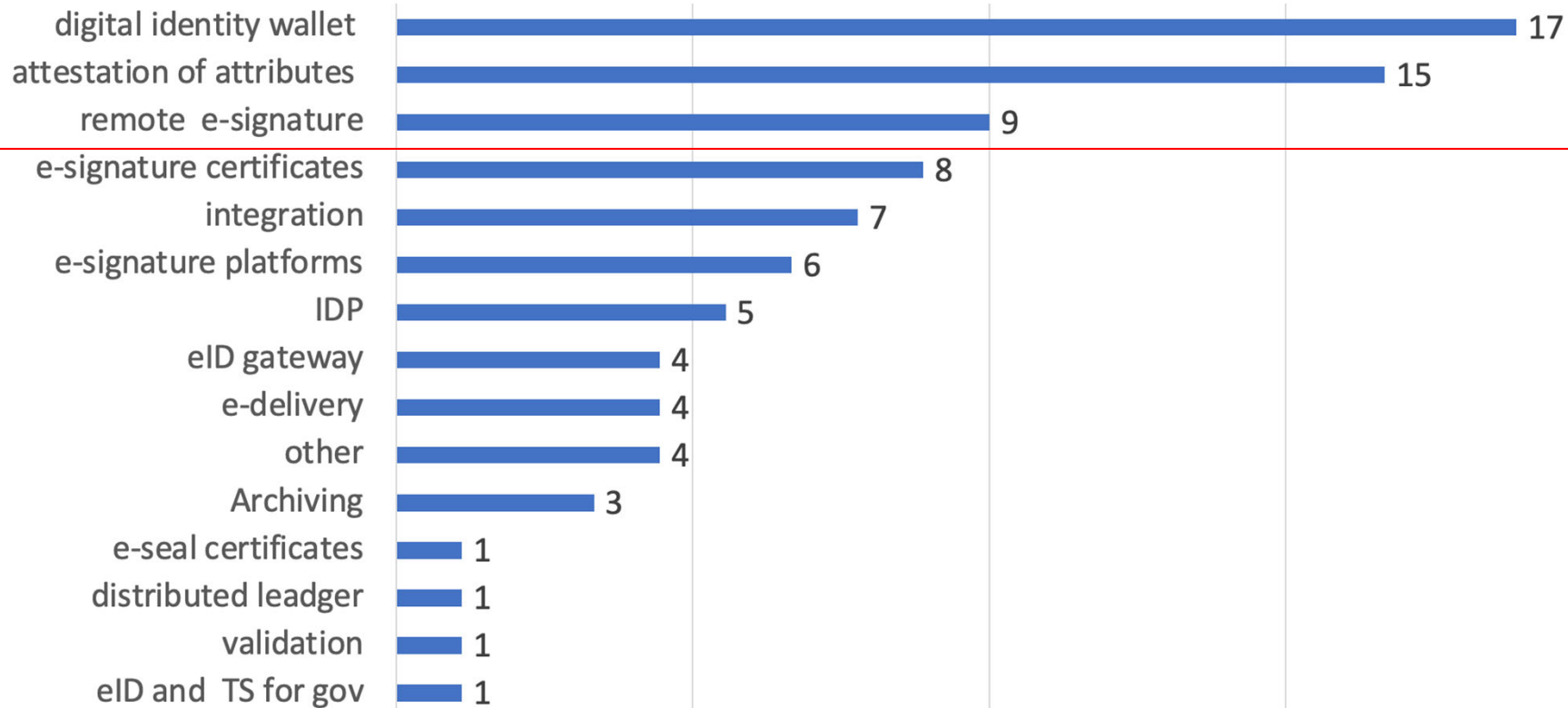
- ▶ Digital Identity Wallet based on planned eIDAS 2.0 – stakeholders EU, local governments, and the commercial sector.
