# REMOTE IDENTIFICATION AND VERIFICATION METHODS UNDER EIDAS

#### eIDAS Art 3 (1): 'electronic identification' means the process of using person identification data in electronic form uniquely representing either a natural or legal person, or a natural person representing a legal person

#### The "right level" of remote identification under eIDAS

- for eID schemes eIDAS Art 8 (2) assurance levels low, substantial or high
- for Trust Services: Art 24 1 (b) remotely, using electronic identification means, [...] meets the requirements set out in Article 8 with regard to the assurance levels 'substantial' or 'high' Art 24 1 (c) by means of a certificate of a qualified electronic signature or of a qualified electronic seal issued in compliance with point (a) or (b);

or

Art 24 1 (d) by using **other identification methods** recognised at national level which provide **equivalent assurance in terms of reliability to physical presence**. [...]

#### Where exactly is the benchmark set?

- for eID schemes COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING REGULATION (EU) 2015/1502 setting out minimum technical specifications and procedures for assurance levels for electronic identification means
- for Trust Services as of Art. 24 1 (d) however
  - no further legal requirements on EU level
  - no normative base connected to eIDAS
  - but different not harmonized national requirement/interpretation sets defined by supervisory bodies

But good news: there are remote identification methods successfully assessed for Trust Services under eIDAS 24 1 (d)!
