EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR DECISION

ED DECISION No 48/2025
OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AGENCY of 3 September 2025,

on amending the ED Decision No 22/2025 on the extension of the mandate of the Ad Hoc Working Group on European Cybersecurity Skills Framework (ECSF) and amending the ED Decisions No 10/2023, 48/2023 and 64/2024

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR CYBERSECURITY

Having regard to

- Regulation (EU) 2019/881 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 April 2019 on ENISA (the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity) and on information and communications technology cybersecurity certification and repealing Regulation (EU) No 526/2013 (Cybersecurity Act), in particular its Article 20 (4);
- Decision No MB/2022/5 of the Management Board of the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity (ENISA) on the establishment and operation of Ad Hoc Working Groups and repealing the MB Decisions No MB/2013/11 and No MB/2019/11:
- ED Decision No 22/2025 of the Executive Director of the Agency of 11 April 2025 on the extension of the mandate
 of the Ad Hoc Working Group on European Cybersecurity Skills Framework (ECSF) and amending the ED Decisions
 No 10/2023, 48/2023 and 64/2024;
- ED Decision No 64/2024 of the Executive Director of the Agency of 13 December 2024, on amending the ED Decisions No 10/2023 and 48/2023 on the establishment of the Ad Hoc Working Group on European Cybersecurity Skills Framework (ECSF);
- ED Decision No 10/2023 of the Executive Director of the Agency of 27 March 2023, on the establishment of the Ad Hoc Working Group on European Cybersecurity Skills Framework (ECSF), as amended by the ED Decision No 48/2023, in particular its Article 3;
- The European Union Agency for Cybersecurity call for interest of 19 December 2022 for applications for the selection
 of members of the European Union Agency for cybersecurity Ad Hoc Working Group on ECSF, with reference to
 the Terms of Reference on the selection of applicants.

Whereas

- By means of the Executive Director Decision No 10/2023, the Executive Director established the Ad Hoc Working on Group on ECSF, which has been amended by the ED Decision No 48/2023 and the ED Decision No 64/2024;
- By means of the ED Decision No 22/2025, the Executive Director extended the mandate of the Ad Hoc Working Group on ECSF for one (1) year, until 23/04/2026, as the scope of the work has not yet been completed;



- One member of the Ad Hoc Working Group on ECSF has joined ENISA Advisory Group and one has joined ENISA
 as a staff member. According to Article 3 (3) of Decision No MB/2022/5, they cannot longer be appointed members
 to the AHWG and shall therefore be replaced via the Reserve List for this AHWG;
- Two new organisations have expressed the interest to participate to the Ad Hoc Working group on ECSF as observers;
- Consequently, the List of Members appointed to the Ad Hoc Working Group on ECSF (Annex 1) and Observer List for the Ad Hoc Working Group on ECSF (Annex 3) require to be updated.

HAS DECIDED

Article 1 Duration of the Ad Hoc Working Group

The mandate of the Ad Hoc Working Group on ECSF is extended for one (1) year, until 23/04/2026...

Article 2 Membership

The annexes to the ED Decision 22/2025 on the extension of the mandate of the Ad Hoc Working Group on European Cybersecurity Skills Framework (ECSF) and amending the ED Decisions No 10/2023, 48/2023 and 64/2024 is amended to include the following changes:
