The Desktop Research Report will identify common themes in already existing NCSS and analyse the structure and regulatory framework which the strategy support.”</p> <p>Does this mean that the Contractor will get a desktop research report as input to its work, or is ENISA expecting the contractor to prepare that report??</p>

It will identify common themes in already developed National Cyber Security Strategies in the EU (and possibly also a few key countries outside). It will analyse the structure and regulatory framework which the strategies support and are developed within. Please see page 20 of the Tender Specifications.</p> <p>If your question refers to the final deliverable, the Good Practice Guide, it will provide useful and practical advice to regulators and policy makers on Good practices regarding the development of a National Cyber Security Strategy.
