### Clarification: No 3

## “Collaboration Facilities for Meeting Rooms”

#### Questions & Answers

<b>Q14:</b>	Do you want also to call remote sites with ISDN or you only receive calls from ISDN/IP devices to IP at ENISA Athens site?
<b>A14:</b>	ENISA only supports receiving calls from ISDN/IP devices to IP. ENISA does not require calling remote sites over ISDN
<b>Q15:</b>	The total budget for Athens and Heraklion is 250,000 for 3 years. You mention in page 5 at the SCOPE of the Tender that up to 150,000 Euro of the total available budget has been allocated to cover the meeting rooms in Athens. That means that our quote cannot be more than total of 150,000 Euros for Athens (even if you decide to spend 100,000 in 2014 and 50,000 in 2015 for Athens, for example). The rest of 250,000 etc. the 100,000 are allocated for Heraklion offices.
<b>A15:</b>	In the ‘Tender Specification’ on page 5 it states “.....up to €150 000,00 of the total available budget under the framework contract has been allocated to cover the meeting rooms in Athens office”. This amount is indicative only as ENISA may decide to implement some or all of the planned installations. The amount of €150,000 should not necessarily be taken by potential tenderers as a guide to how much to quote for all the meeting rooms described. We welcome competitive offers for quality equipment as described in the technical specification, keeping in mind that the awarding of points for each offer is at the ratio of 60% quality versus 40% price.
