Questions & Answers

Q1:	Does the reference to MSEL on page 10 of the tender indicate that you expect MSEL functionality to be offered as part of the CEP?
A1:	The functions that we expect to be part of the CEP package include all the necessary modules which will allow the user to manage MSELs. This means that the CEP must support functionality to create, edit, and in general manipulate MSELs.
	In our understanding a MSEL is a collection of prescripted events intended to guide an exercise. Ideally we would like to be able to do bunch operations (like collectively move events in time etc.). The way this functionality will be offered is left to the individual bidders to propose.
