Questions & Answers

<p>Q1:</p>	<p>With reference to bullets no. 3,4,5 of Junior Expert profile and bullets no. 4,5,6 of Senior Expert profile which refer to the same requirements, we understand that these areas of knowledge may not be provided exclusively by all the CVs but should be covered by the overall Pools of Experts (Junior and Senior) as a whole. Could you please confirm that our understanding is correct? For example, it is our understanding that if a Senior Expert is proficient in “the European and international frameworks concerning network information security” as well as in “the European legal framework concerning network information security” but lacks / misses experience or knowledge in “interdisciplinary knowledge of areas related to NIS” he/she will not be excluded, given that other Experts cover this area of knowledge.</p>
<p>A1:</p>	<p>Yes, we confirm.</p>
<p>Q2:</p>	<p>Tenderers are requested to submit the CVs of a pool of Experts (Senior and Junior). We understand that in case that one CV out of this Pool does not succeed in satisfying the specified requirements, only that expert will be dropped and not the whole tender. Could you please confirm?</p>
<p>A2:</p>	<p>We will evaluate tenders as a whole and not individual CVs.</p>

Q3:	With reference to the Professional Experience requirements for the Senior and Junior Experts, we understand that the years of studies (MSc and PhD studies) in the field of network information security shall be considered in the total years of professional experience of each expert. Could you please confirm? If not, neither PhD studies in the field of NIS shall be considered as professional experience?
A3:	Yes, we confirm.
