Questions & Answers

Q1:	<p>In the description of task 3 (section 2.3), it is stated that the contractor should “organize or contribute to the organization of workshops and the drafting of minutes of the workshops”. This request is very vague and can hardly be incorporated properly into an offer.</p> <p>Could you please specify in more detail what you expect from offering contractors in this regard.</p>
A1:	<p>The contractor should assist ENISA in organising the eHealth workshop that will take place in 2015 by creating the agenda (structure, speakers format etc) based on the knowledge obtained through the study.</p> <p>If needed the contractor should be at the workshop and take minutes of the discussion panels.</p> <p>The whole event will be organised by ENISA (ENISA will cover costs etc) which includes the logistics (venue, dissemination services etc) and the contractor will not have to be involved in this.</p>
Q2:	<p>In the description of task 1 (section 2.1), it is stated that experts from five extra-EU countries are expected to participate in the surveys.</p> <p>Do you rather expect experts from European non-EU countries or from other regions such as South-East Asia or the Americas to be involved</p>
A2:	<p>The focus of the study should be the European EU countries; if there is a contact in another country and the information provided is important, they can be included in the stakeholders' list.</p> <p>However the contractor shouldn't spend time on finding contact points in these countries.</p>
