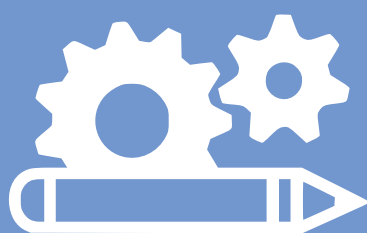
All you need to know

The EU Cyber Solidarity Act, in force since **February 2025**, establishes the EU Cybersecurity Reserve. It enables trusted security providers to support response and recovery in major cybersecurity incidents affecting Member States, EU institutions, or DEP-associated third countries.

WHAT FOR?



Support response and initiate recovery actions in the case of significant cybersecurity incidents, large-scale cybersecurity incidents or large-scale-equivalent cybersecurity incidents.
