The EU Cyber Solidarity Act, in force since February 2025, establishes the EU Cybersecurity Reserve. It enables trusted security providers to support response and recovery in major cybersecurity incidents affecting Member States, EU institutions, or DEP-associated third countries.

Support response and initiate recovery actions in the case of significant cybersecurity incidents, large-scale cybersecurity incidents or large-scale-equivalent cybersecurity incidents.
