

Data Protection Notice

ENISA Alerts Service

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data¹.

The legal basis for the processing operation is article 5(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 (consent).

The purpose of the processing operation is to manage user subscriptions and to send email notifications to subscribed users when new content matching their stated interests is published. For this purpose, personal data consisting of an email address and, where voluntarily provided, a name are processed. This includes registering and maintaining the subscription, delivering the requested alerts, and managing related communications such as subscription confirmation and unsubscribe requests. The data are processed solely for these purposes and are not used for unrelated communications or marketing activities.

This processing operation relates to Record No 73 - Mailing List available under [ENISA's register of data processing activities](#).

The data controller of the processing operation is ENISA, Executive Director's Office (EDO).

The data processors for this processing operation are:

- EC DG DIGIT, under an SLA with ENISA, providing hosting services.
- Unisystems S.A. (<https://www.unisystems.com/>) and Eau De Web (<https://eaudeweb.ro/>) providing web development, support and maintenance services under a Framework Contract with ENISA.

The following **personal data are processed**:

- Email address;
- Name (optional);
- Subscription preferences (e.g. selected topics or areas of interest).

Access to your personal data is granted only to designated ENISA staff and designated staff of the ENISA processors to extent that these data are necessary for the processors' scope of operations.

The data may also be available to EU bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office - OLAF).

Transfers of personal data **outside the EU/EEA is not** foreseen.

Retention Period

Personal data is retained for as long as the user remains subscribed to the alert service. The data is deleted without undue delay once the user unsubscribes.

You have the right of access to your personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it. You have the right to rectify your personal data. Under certain conditions, you have the right to ask that we delete your personal data or restrict its use. You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time. We will consider your request, take a decision and communicate it to you.
