

Data Protection Notice – 3rd Awareness Raising Conference

Your personal data will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

The joint data controllers of the processing operation are ENISA (Capacity Building Unit), Jönköping University and RISE which are the co-organisers of the conference and responsible for the logistics.

ENISA is responsible for facilitating participants' registration for the event through the ENISA website, making conference material available online and follow up of the conference with registered participants, including feedback collection.

The legal basis for the processing operation is Article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, on the basis of [Regulation \(EU\) 2019/881](#), in particular the provisions establishing the tasks of ENISA. The other two joint data controllers rely on Article 6(1)(e) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) as the legal basis for their processing.

The purpose of the processing operation is to facilitate the registration and participations to the 3rd Awareness Raising Conference and any related communication activities before and after the event, including feedback collection, sharing conference material among participants and making publicly available recorded sessions, if any, and pictures from the conference (for the speakers and participants who have provided their consent).

The data processors are:

- **EC DG DIGIT**, under an SLA with ENISA, providing ENISA website hosting services.
- **Unisystems S.A.** and **Eau De Web** providing web development, support and maintenance services under a Framework Contract with ENISA.

The following personal data are processed:

- First Name
- Last Name
- Current job title
- Email
- Affiliation
- Country

Recipients of the above-mentioned personal data are designated ENISA staff, who are involved in the organisation of the event, as well as staff designated by the other two joint controllers, Jönköping

University and RISE, as well as aforementioned processors. The data may also be available to EU bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF).

Data Transfers

No transfers outside EU/EEA are foreseen.

Retention Periods

Personal data of respondents will be kept up to a maximum period of three (3) months after the survey deadline but the information listed in the report's acknowledgment section will remain on ENISA website for the lifetime of the report.

Participants have:

- the **right of access** to their personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it.
- the **right to rectify** their personal data by contacting awareness@enisa.europa.eu.
- the **right to request to delete or restrict** your personal data, unless this interferes with the rights and freedoms of other data subjects, legal obligations to retain your data or other relevant interests that prevent the Agency from meeting your request. The Agency will inform you if any of these interests interfere with your personal request.
- the **right to object to our processing** of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time.
