DATA PROTECTION NOTICE

ENISA AI CYBERSECURITY CONFERENCE

ENISA AI Cybersecurity Conference is organised by the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity (ENISA). It will take place in a hybrid format on the 7th of June 2023.

Your personal data in the context of the ENISA AI Cybersecurity Conference is processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data.

The data controller of the processing operation is ENISA.

The data processors are:

- ENISA's contractor EaudeWeb, based in Romania, that hosts the ENISA's web services;
- CISCO, provider of the teleconference platform (Webex) under a contract with ENISA;
- The European Commission, which it is the platform (EUSurvey tool) used for the online registration of the participants for the conference

The legal basis for the processing operations is article 5(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, on the basis of Regulation (EU) 2019/881 (Cybersecurity Act), especially the provisions establishing the tasks of ENISA.

The purpose of this processing operation is to register interested persons to ENISA's conference on Al cybersecurity, provide access to the conference venue, as well as allow the follow up of the conference, including feedback collection and specific communication activities.

The following personal data is collected:

- Contact data: first name, last name, organisation, position (optional) and e-mail address.
- Connection details for virtual sessions: username, email address (optional), IP address, user agent identifier, hardware type, operation system type and version and further technical connection data. These data are processed by CISCO in order to provide for the event and for analytics purposes.
- User generated information: discussion chat logs. This data is produced through the CISCO WebEx platform during the event. It will be processed by ENISA and deleted from the CISCO WebEx platform after the end of the event.

The recipients of your data will be designated ENISA staff involved in the organisation of the conference, designated staff of ENISA's contractors involved in the event, and bodies charged with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF). Operators of Cisco Webex will have access to personal data related to the connection and use of the teleconference platform for the provision of the specific service. Data related to the





connection/use of the teleconference platforms are stored within EU/EEA and may include transfers of personal data outside EU/EEA.

The retention period for the personal data is as follows: the participants' contact data will be kept by ENISA for a maximum period of 6 months after the end of the events, unless the participants have provided their consent upon registration for further processing by ENISA (in order for the participants to get informed about future ENISA activities and events). In the latter case, ENISA will keep the contact data until the participants withdraw their consent.

You have the right of access to your personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it. You have the right to rectify your personal data. Under certain conditions, you have the right to ask that we delete your personal data or restrict its use. You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time. We will consider your request, take a decision and communicate it to you. You have the right of recourse at any time to the ENISA DPO at <u>dataprotection@enisa.europa.eu</u> and to the European Data Protection Supervisor at https://edps.europa.eu.
