

# DECISION NO MB/2019/7 OF THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN UNION AGENCY FOR CYBERSECURITY

## authorizing an occupational activity after leaving the service

THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF ENISA,

**Having regard to** Regulation (EU) (EU) 2019/881 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 April 2019 on ENISA (the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity) and on information and communications technology cybersecurity certification and repealing Regulation (EU) No 526/2013 (Cybersecurity Act)<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 15.1 (I);

**Having regard to** Article 16 of the Staff Regulations of officials and the conditions of employment of other servants of the European Union of 01.01.2014.

**Having regard to** the Decision No MB/2018/19 of the Management Board of ENISA on outside activities and assignments and on occupational activities after leaving the service, and in particular Articles 19, 20, and 21;

### Whereas

- The term of office of the present Executive Director ends on 15 October 2019 and on 27 September 2019 he has informed the Executive Board about his intention to engage in an occupational activity after leaving the service.
- During the term of the ENISA Executive Director from 16 October 2009 until 15 October 2019 Udo Helmbrecht was on unpaid leave as a civil servant of the German government.
- On 16 October 2019 Udo Helmbrecht will return to Germany as a Professor at the Universität der Bundeswehr München with a remuneration according to the German staff regulation for civil servants.
- The Management Board as the Appointing Authority shall notify its decision within 30 days after being informed of the occupational activity.
- The Executive Board has discussed this matter at its meeting held on 30 September 2019.
