



PRIVACY STATEMENT – ENISA'S INFORMAL EXPERT GROUP

Your personal data shall be processed in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data¹.

The data controller of the processing operation is ENISA CSIRTs Relation (CR) team.

The legal basis for the processing operation is: i) Article 5(1) (a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, on the basis of Regulation (EU) No 526/2013, in particular the provisions establishing the tasks of ENISA, ii) Article 5(1) (d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725– consent of data subjects.

The purpose of this processing operation is the creation and maintenance of ENISA's Informal Expert Groups for receiving expert input on ENISA products in the broader area of CSIRTs.

The data processors of this processing operation will be entities contracted by ENISA to carry out studies in the broader area of CSIRTs, whenever reports and/or other deliverables produced during these studies will require input from ENISA's Informal Expert Groups.

The following personal data are being processed:

First name, last name, organization that is represented, title/position, e-mail address, CVs (for the candidate selection process or for selected Informal Expert Group members).

Opinions/feedback from selected Informal Expert Group members in the form of written/verbal comments or via forms will not generally contain personal data, except specific cases on ad hoc basis.

The recipients of the data will be: designated ENISA staff involved in the data processing operation (ENISA CR Team), as well as ENISA contractors (data processors) supporting the data processing operation (e.g. Compagnie Européenne d'Intelligence Stratégique (CEIS) — European Strategic Intelligence Company). The data may also be available to EU bodies charged

with monitoring or inspection tasks in application of EU law (e.g. internal audits, European Anti-fraud Office – OLAF).

Personal data of selected members of Informal Expert groups will be kept as long as an Expert Group formally exists or for the duration of individual membership in the Expert Group and for additional 2 years after the end of the aforementioned periods for audit purposes. Personal data of candidates that have not been selected as members of an Informal Expert Group are kept for up to 6 months after the end of the selection process.

You have the right of access to your personal data and to relevant information concerning how we use it. You have the right to rectify your personal data. Under certain conditions, you have the right to ask that we delete your personal data or restrict its use. You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time. We will consider your request, take a decision and communicate it to you.
